



## Diocese of the Rocky Mountains Ordination Exam Reading List, Study Guide, and Syllabus

### COURSE DESCRIPTION & IMPORTANT NOTES

- **Overview:** Perhaps the key idea as regards these exams is that they are designed for formation, not rejection. They are intended to identify where an Ordinand has a solid understanding of the material or where they may need to do some follow-up work. The follow-up can range from re-writing entire questions to some extra reading and a discussion with the person who graded the exams.
- **Format:** This is one set of an exam with four parts: Bible, Anglican Theology & Polity, Systematics, and Practical Theology. Exams 1 & 2 are taken during Aspirancy and 3 & 4 during Postulancy.
- **The Vocational Deacons Exam** is a subset of the questions in the first 3 parts of the Presbyterian's Exam (Bible, Anglican Theology, and Systematics), and then there is a separate fourth part related to the particular call of a Vocational Deacon. The required subset portions for a Vocational Deacon to study are noted in the syllabus below with an asterisk (\*).
- **Grading/Writing Expectations:** The grading is intended to approximate the comprehensive finals after an MDiv for a Presbyterian, and an Undergraduate Theology Degree for a Deacon. The Ordinand is expected to submit work and writing accordingly.
- **Preparation:** *Please be sure to do the readings*, as the reading list and syllabus have been created to guide and prepare you for the exam and will potentially reduce the amount of follow-up and additional work or conversations needed after grading, and it honors the graders, who will put a lot of time and effort into grading the exams.
- **Scheduling:** Please read the Credentialing Manual for instructions on scheduling exams with the Diocesan Admin (and cc: Canon Matt). If accommodations are needed for the exams, please email the Diocesan Admin and Canon Matt.
  - Please send in an anticipated schedule for taking the 2-4 exams so that we can space them out amongst our graders' schedules. The goal is to provide a comfortable and steady schedule for these exams. Perhaps every other month is a good schedule that will allow for adequate study time without being onerous and keep you in a somewhat regular rhythm of studying and writing.
- **Guidelines for taking exams (FAQs):** You are allowed one day (8 hours) for the entire exam (per part, ie, Exam 1, Exam 2).
  - Exams are open Bible (unmarked) and book(s) to the books on the reading list.
  - Use of the internet is strictly for resources on syllabus.
  - The best answers show interaction amongst all of these resources. Please be prepared to engage with the resources so that we can understand what you think (and not just what your source thinks).
  - The majority of the writing should be your own words.
    - Citations/quotations should be used to support your words/statement, not to make a statement or define something.
    - Citations/quotations should be appropriately noted. Any format is acceptable as long as it is consistent throughout the exam.

## REQUIRED TEXTS

**Scripture - Please use one of the following English translations for the exams:**

- English Standard Version (ESV)
- New Kings James Version (NKJV)

We ask that you use one of these two translations, not because DRM churches can only use these two. For guidance in corporate worship, see the Bishop's Customaries. We use these two for the exams because they consistently translate *hilasterion*-related words as *propitiation*. This is significant for two reasons. One, the concept of propitiation is becoming less understood, yet it is a key image of The Atonement. Also, it is a significant word and concept in our Anglican formularies and so its Biblical usage is important to reading our formularies.
